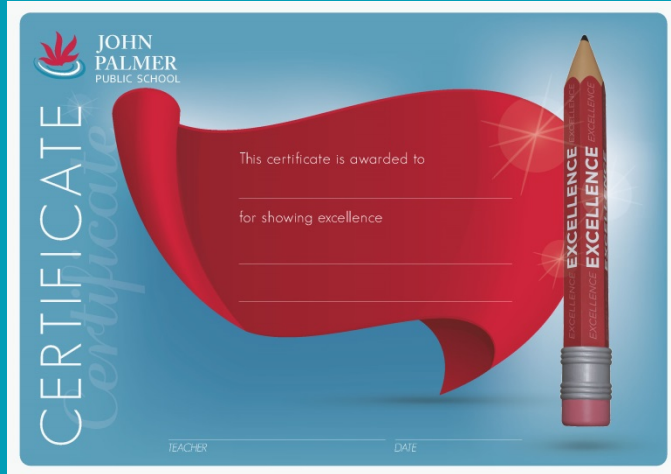

# Opportunity Classes

What are Opportunity Classes?

Opportunity classes cater for highly achieving Year 5 and Year 6 academically gifted students who may otherwise be without classmates at their own academic and social level.

Opportunity classes help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Placement is determined through:

- English language, mathematics and general ability results of the set standardised test
- School assessment scores in English and Mathematics.

- To establish a home study routine

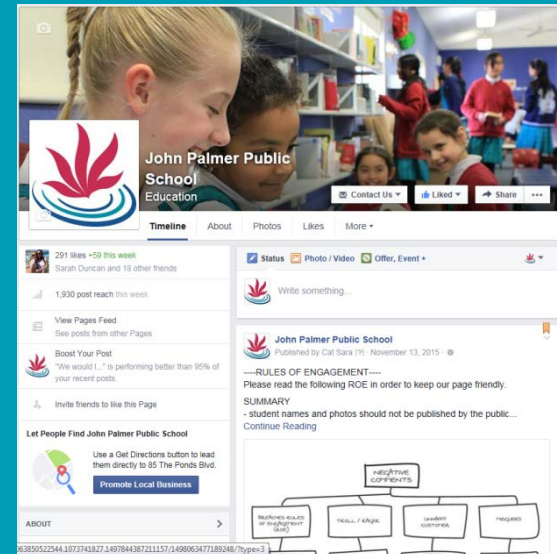
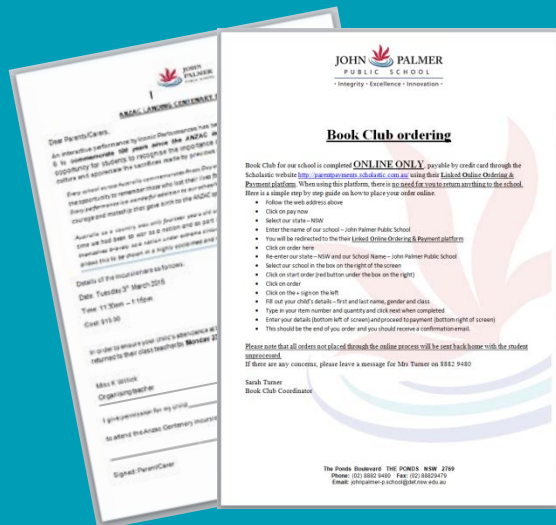


