Dear Parents/Carers

At the start of each year we ask for a voluntary school contribution. Schools rely upon these voluntary contributions made by parents to provide improved educational opportunities and maintain the quality resources that enhance your child's learning experiences at John Palmer Public School.

We always aim to keep any additional costs to a minimum and 100% of the funds collected through these contributions go directly to enhancing the educational opportunities for students. The contribution for 2019 is \$49 per student, capped at \$98 per family.

- 3. You can also pay with your 'Fees in Advance' OR
- 4. Pay at the counter using our EFTPOS facilities.
